Responsibilities

- Manage oikos Family, our external network
- Maintain communication with the existing pilot project at KU while providing support in terms of resources and best practice
- Actively research and brainstorm options for future collaborations
- Support the development of prototype projects developed through the engagement of the oikos Family network, or other outlets
- Support the handover process
- Lead and engage a team composed of the projects' Accelerator Managers
- Participate in board meetings and develop the organization's strategic direction
- Drive knowledge sharing from board to the Accelerator team and vice versa
- Drive knowledge sharing across projects between the Accelerator members

Activities

- Hold weekly meetings with the Accelerator team and Board
- Maintain contact with prototype projects and setting directions, milestones, strategies to progress the projects further
- Draft overall plan of action for individual projects and, overall, for the accelerator function
- Organize workshops and idea generation meetings to create a flourishing ground for potentially new initiatives
